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**San Joaquin County Hospital Admissions Increasing Amid COVID-19**

French Camp, Calif. – Hospital Intensive Care Units (ICU) in the County are operating at **132% capacity** while total hospital capacity is **at 76%**.

Today's report of 236 COVID positive patients being treated in hospitals within San Joaquin County marks a significant rise in hospitalizations, with a reported 80 COVID positive patients receiving intensive care.

“The need for intensive care services for COVID patients nearly exceeds the licensed ICU bed capacity within the county,” said Dan Burch, San Joaquin County EMS Administrator. “Hospitals are expanding intensive care services to meet the patient surge creating additional ICU beds and shifting staff to meet demand.”

Do not delay seeking care. If you are experiencing a medical emergency such as a heart attack, stroke, difficulty breathing or altered mental status contact 911 to activate the EMS system. If you are ill or sick contact your physician or healthcare provider.

**How People Can Protect Themselves:**

**DO:** Stay home; Avoid people outside your household; Wash hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds; Wear a face mask when out in public; Cover your cough or sneeze; Frequently clean and disinfect touched objects and surfaces; Maintain physical distance of six feet whenever outside of the house; Stay away from work, school or other people if you become sick with respiratory symptoms like fever and cough.

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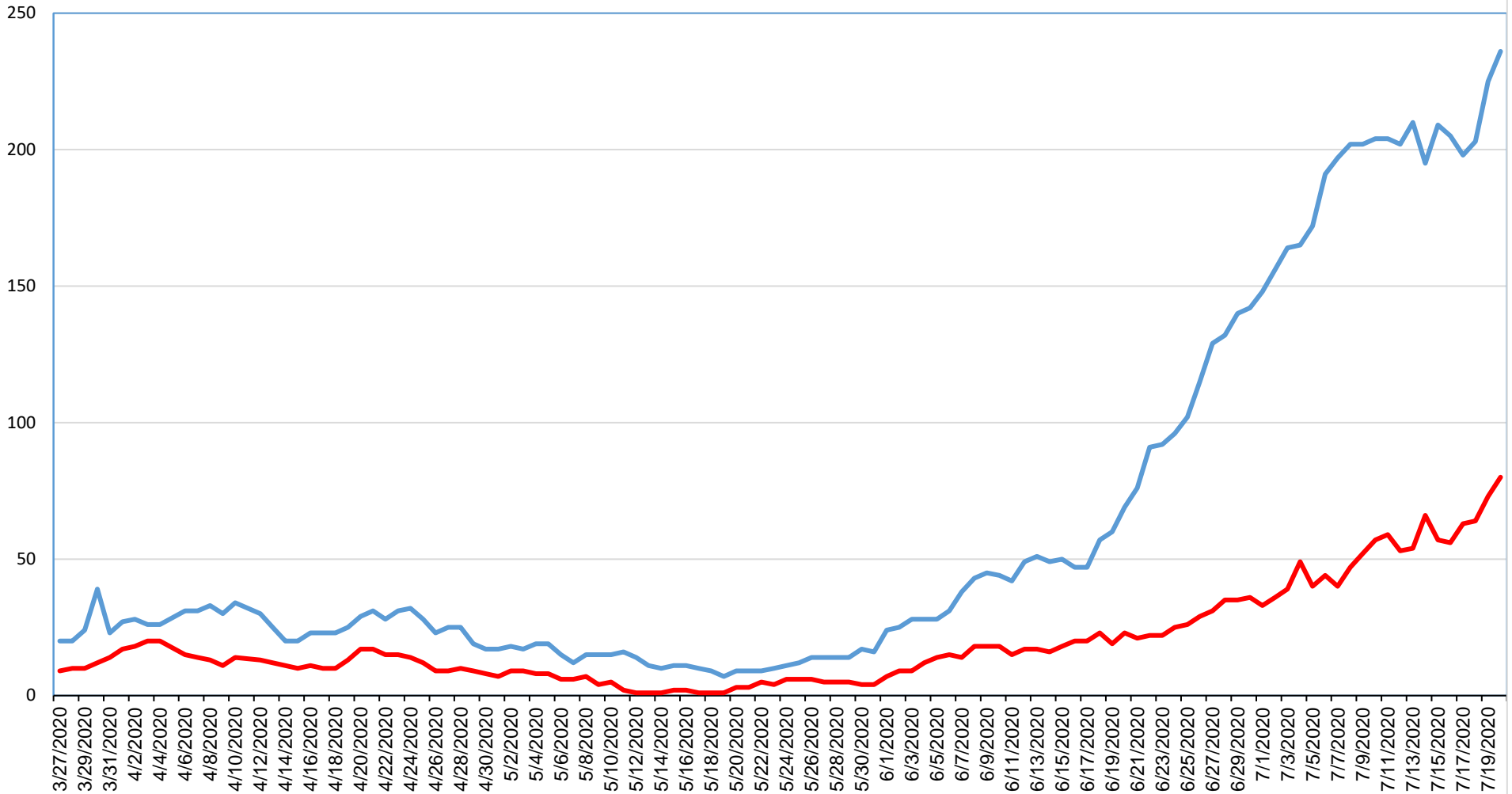
