San Joaquin County Parks To Close Ahead of Pending Storm

Closure in effect beginning Wednesday, Jan. 4, 2023

San Joaquin County Parks will close all regional, community and neighborhood parks effective Wednesday, January 4, 2023 ahead of the impending storm, park officials have announced.

With the upcoming storm producing possible wind gusts of up to 60 MPH, park officials have closed all parks, including Micke Grove Regional Park, Oak Grove Regional Park, Regional Sports Complex, Dos Reis Regional Park, Mossdale Crossing Regional Park, and Westgate Landing Regional Park. In conjunction with the park closures, Dos Reis campground and boat launch, Westgate Landing campground, Mossdale Crossing boat launch facilities will also close. The closure is expected to last through Thursday, Jan. 5, with the potential to extend into Friday, Jan. 6, depending on weather and park conditions.

Micke Grove Regional Park and Micke Grove Zoo, sustained significant flooding and wind damage during the New Year's Eve storm. Micke Grove will remain closed through Sunday January 8, 2023 as park staff continues to assess damages and clear roadways.
