Storm Assistance for Immigrants (SAI) it is a state program to help undocumented individuals whose jobs, housing, and daily lives were affected due to the storms. These individuals were not eligible to receive Federal aid due to their immigration status. The assistance provided will include limited one-time financial aid.

No appointments will be given to clients to sign up for this financial aid. All document submissions will be done in a clinic setting. Every clinic will be on a first come first serve basis, where clients will be seen as time permits. Anyone not seen is welcome to attend the next clinic schedule, where they will be seen in the order, they show up in. You must have all the documents ready before the clinic you attend. Your case will not be considered until you have all the documents requested. FUNDS CAN BE EXHAUSTED AT ANY TIME.

Possible Financial Assistance Awarded

- Adults 18 years and older can receive up to \$1,500
- Up to three children who are 17 and younger can receive \$500 per each child (If one of the children is over 18, they can have their own application as an adult)
- The household can receive a maximum of \$4,500 in total

Who Can Apply?

- Individuals with undefined immigrant status (Only undocumented members of the household may receive SAI's financial aid). Individuals with DACA can also apply
- Individuals must reside or work in San Joaquin County
- Individuals must have suffered loss due to the storms

Required Documents for all Adults and eligible children in the Household

- Identification (Driver's license, passport, birth certificate, school ID, consulate ID)
- Proof of residency in the San Joaquin County (a bill, Driver's License, school letters)
- Proof of hardship caused by the storms (Letter from your employer saying you were unable to work because of the storms, or other evidence of loss)
- Proof that the children you are claiming are in the U.S. (School identification, or school letters, or Medi-Cal card)

If one document cannot be obtained, it may be possible to prepare a declaration instead of submitting the document. Please contact El Concilio to attend an orientation session. Funds can be spent at any time, gather all the documents you can as soon as possible!

***If the individual/family has all the required documentation and is approved, financial assistance will be provided by check or debit card, with the amount approved by the State, while funding lasts. ***
